- The Kansas City Deanery will be starting up another three-year sequence this coming fall (2021). *When the stone had been sealed by the Jews;
While the soldiers were guarding Your most
Pure Body;
You rose on the third day, O Savior,
Granting Life to the world.
The powers of heaven therefore cried to You O
Giver of Life:
"Glory to Your Resurrection, O Christ!
Glory to Your Kingdom!
Glory to Your divine plan, for You alone love
mankind!*

Troparion for John the Baptist (Tone 2)

*The memory of the righteous is celebrated with
hymns of praise,
But the Lord's testimony is sufficient for you, O
Forerunner.
You were shown in truth to be the most
honorable of the prophets,
For you were deemed worthy to baptize in the
streams of the Jordan Him you foretold.
Therefore, having suffered for the truth with joy,
You proclaimed to those in hell God who
appeared in the flesh,
Who takes away the sin of the world,
And grants us great mercy.*

raising the world with Yourself.
Human nature sings Your praise as God, for
death has vanished.
Adam dances for joy, O Master!
And Eve, now freed from her bonds, cries out to

The Reading from the 1st Epistle of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Corinthians 1 Corinthians 4:9-16

Brothers and sisters: For I think that God has displayed us, the apostles, last, as men condemned to death; for we have been made a spectacle to the world, both to angels and to men. We are fools for Christ's sake, but you are wise in Christ! We are weak, but you are strong! You are distinguished, but we are dishonored! To the present hour we both hunger and thirst, and we are poorly clothed, and beaten, and homeless. And we labor, working with our own hands. Being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we endure; being defamed, we entreat. We have been made as the filth of the world, the offscouring of all things until now. I do not write these things to shame you, but as my beloved children I warn you. For though you might have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet you do not have many fathers; for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel. Therefore I beseech you, to follow me.
