Nativity of the Theotokos Troparion (Tone 4)

Your Nativity. O Virgin

Has proclaimed joy to the whole universe! The Sun of Righteousness, Christ our God, Has shone from you, O Theotokos! By annulling the curse,

He bestowed a blessing.

By destroying death, He has granted us eternal

Resurrection Kontakion (Tone 3)

On this day You rose from the tomb. O Compassionate Lord. Leading us out from the gates of death. Adam dances for joy today and Eve rejoices. Together with the prophets and patriarchs, They never cease to sing the praise of the Divine power of Your might.

Nativity of the Theotokos Kontakion (Tone 4)

By your Nativity, O most pure Virgin, Joachim and Anna are freed from barrenness: Adam and Eve. from the corruption of death. And we, your people, freed from the guilt of sin, celebrate and sing to you:

The barren woman gives birth to the Theotokos, the Nourisher of our Life.

The Reading from the 1st Epistle of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Corinthians 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

Brothers and sisters: I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve. After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time. For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me. Therefore, whether it was I or they, so we preach and so you believed.
